On January 10, 2011, Ross Lieberman, American Cable Association, William P. Rogerson, Professor, Northwestern University, and the undersigned had a phone conversation with Joshua Cinelli, media advisor to Commissioner Michael J. Copps, in regard to the above-referenced docket. Mr. Lieberman, Professor Rogerson and I discussed the inadequacies of the conditions proposed by the Chairman to mitigate harms to smaller multichannel video programming distributors (MVPDs) from the proposed combination of Comcast and NBC Universal, as indicated by press and analyst reports. Moreover, we talked about remedies that would work effectively for smaller MVPDs. The views expressed were consistent with ACA’s past *ex parte* filings.
