On January 12, 2011, the undersigned had a phone conversation with Angela Kronenberg, Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn. This conversation follows a prior conversation on January 9, 2011 with Ms. Kronenberg where I discussed the inadequacies of the conditions proposed by the Chairman for smaller multichannel video programming distributors (MVPDs) to mitigate harms from the proposed combination of Comcast and NBC Universal. In this conversation, I specifically discussed how to amend the conditions proposed by the Chairman to ensure they are effective for smaller MVPDs. All of these views are consistent with ACA’s past filings.
