REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

WDJT Limited Partnership, licensee of WDJT-TV, Milwaukee, Wisconsin (“WDJT”), by its attorneys, hereby requests an extension of time, until January 28, 2011, to file a response to the minor modification applications and updated showing filed on January 4 and 7, 2011, respectively, in support of the channel change petition submitted by WWAZ-DT, Fond du Lac, Wisconsin (“WWAZ”).

On December 23, 2010, the Media Bureau released a letter (DA 10-2408) (the “Letter”) requesting that WWAZ License, LLC, the licensee of WWAZ, supplement its technical showing in connection with its petition to change the allotment of WWAZ from Channel 44 to Channel 5 and to file the requisite license modification applications to reflect the necessary technical changes to the allotment proposal. WWAZ submitted its minor change applications and supplemental showing on January 4 and 7, 2011, respectively.


The Letter provides that WDJT will have ten days to respond to the updated showing submitted by WWAZ. However, because both the Letter and the updated showing were

served on WDJT's former FCC counsel, the undersigned current FCC counsel to WDJT did not receive all of the documents until today. In order to allow WDJT an adequate opportunity to respond to the updated showing and to ensure a complete record, WDJT respectfully requests an extension of time, until January 28, 2011, to file its response.

Please be advised that FCC counsel to WWAZ has consented to this extension request. In addition, FCC counsel to WLS Television, Inc., the licensee of WLS-TV, Chicago, Illinois, and the sole other party in the above-referenced proceeding, also has consented to this extension request. Accordingly, no party to this proceeding will be adversely affected if the requested extension of time is granted.
