Re: City of Chesapeake Lease Administrative Fee, PS Docket No. 06-229

Dear Admiral Barnett:

On November 5, 2010, the Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau ("PSHSB") granted the City of Chesapeake, Virginia ("Chesapeake") a 30-day extension of time to pay the lease administrative fee due to the Public Safety Spectrum Trust ("PSST") for administration of the long-term *de facto* spectrum lease between the PSST and Chesapeake.¹ On December 13, 2010, the PSHSB granted Chesapeake an additional extension of the payment deadline until January 14, 2011.² This letter is to report that the PSST did not receive the lease administrative fee from Chesapeake by the extended payment deadline.
