
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 20, 2011, Sean Belanger, CEO, John Harris, CTO and William Cobb, VP, Marketing, all of CSDVRS, LLC. ("ZVRS") and David Phillips of Provident Equity, met with Paul de Sa, Chief, Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis, and Nicholas Alexander of the Wireline Competition Bureau.

Consistent with previously filed comments, CSDVRS discussed with the Commission members the economies scale achieved by VRS providers as minute volume increases. Additionally, CSDVRS discussed the reasonably straight-forward nature in which current providers could modify their equipment to allow a consumer to choose a different VRS provider without losing any features in their existing equipment. Finally, CSDVRS discussed that a mandated minimum SIP-based standard with the appropriate implementation guidelines would best serve the entire community of VRS users without necessarily losing any of the value-added features or consumer choice.
