Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 20, 2011, Joan Marsh, Cathy Carpino, and the undersigned of AT&T met with Christi Shewman, Trent Harkrader, and Vickie Robinson of the Wireline Competition Bureau.

AT&T once again strongly urged the FCC to take immediate action on the above named petition (Petition) filed on July 30, 2010. AT&T expressed concern that continued Bureau delay could jeopardize the company's ability to meet its service commitments. AT&T is upgrading the facilities located on the Reservation and is, from a network perspective, on track to transition to 3G service throughout the area. Continued uncertainty about the status of the Petition, however, threatens the ability of the company to deliver the no-cost 3G handsets that are essential for consumers to maintain uninterrupted service.
