PURPLE COMMUNICATIONS, INC.’S ANNUAL COMPLIANCE REPORT

Purple Communications, Inc. (“Purple”) and its wholly owned subsidiary Purple Language Services, Inc., (formerly Hands On Video Relay Services, Inc. (“Hands On”)) (collectively “Company”), pursuant to FCC Rule Sections 64.606(a)(2)(viii) and 64.606(g), submit their annual report on compliance with the mandatory minimum standards established for providers of Video Relay Service (“VRS”). This report covers all brands operated by the Company, including I-711, IP-Relay, and HOVRS.

The Company incorporates in this document information from the following documents filed on Docket 03-123:

- a. Hands On Application for Certification as a Relay Provider (“Hands On Application”) (October 4, 2006);
- b. GoAmerica Application for Amendment of its Telecommunications relay Services Certification (“GoAmerica Application”) to provide IP CTS April 21, 2008.
- c. GoAmerica Application for Amendment of its Telecommunications relay Services Certification (“GoAmerica Amended Application”) to provide IP CTS May 1, 2008.
- d. Annual Report on Meeting Waived Requirements (April 17, 2009).
- e. Annual Report on Meeting Waived Requirements (April 16, 2010).

On December 22, 2006, the Commission granted Hands On’s Application. *See* DA 06-2578. The Commission granted GoAmerica’s Application on June 9, 2006, DA 06-1244, and its Amended Application on November 15, 2008. *See* FCC DA-2514. The three Applications explained in detail how the Company would comply with each of the minimum mandatory standards applicable to relay providers. In preparation of this report, the Company has reviewed the above-listed documents for their continued accuracy in describing the Company’s compliance with applicable VRS mandatory minimum standards. Based on this review, the Company incorporates by reference the factual statements contained in the above-mentioned documents and certifies that the compliance statements made in those documents remain true and accurate for the Company’s current operations. The Company is in compliance with all applicable mandatory minimum standards under 47 C.F.R. § 64.604.
