On January 31, 2011, I met with Joel Gurin, Bureau Chief of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau, and Mark Stone, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau.

In light of AT&T Wireless' and Verizon Wireless' changes to its plans, I urged the Commission to quickly initiate a truth in billing proceeding that would set clear transparency standards so consumers are made aware of billing standards and practices throughout the industry. I also stressed the importance of quickly adopting rules that would address "bill shock" once the comment cycle ends.
