This letter is to inform you that on February 8, 2011, I left brief voicemail messages for Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff to Chairman Julius Genachowski, and Rick Kaplan, Chairman Genachowski's Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor, regarding the above-referenced proceeding. My comments were consistent with T-Mobile's prior filings in this proceeding. I urged the Commission to act now to establish an automatic data roaming right on just, reasonable and non-discriminatory terms and conditions. I also reiterated the importance of data roaming to competition and consumers and the fact that, excepting the two largest wireless carriers, there is broad consensus regarding the importance and need for a basic data roaming right.
