On February 16, 2011, Barrington Broadcasting Group, LLC, Belo Corp., Dispatch Broadcast Group, Gannett Co., Inc., Post-Newsweek Stations, Inc., and Raycom Media, Inc., represented by Dunia Shive, CEO of Belo Corp., Dave Lougee, President, Broadcasting Division, Gannett Co., Inc., and Jon Blake and Kurt Wimmer of Covington & Burling, met with Steven Waldman and Elizabeth Andrion to discuss issues relating to the future of media proceeding.
