This letter is to inform you that the undersigned met with Rick Kaplan, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski, on February 17, 2011, to discuss the critical need for special access reform. Sprint urged the Commission to complete expeditiously all data collection needed to evaluate the competitiveness of the special access market and to implement needed reforms to ensure that the rates, terms and conditions governing the RBOCs' provision of interstate special access services are just and reasonable. Sprint's arguments were consistent with its previous filings in this docket.
