
Based on instructions from Mr. Rodney McDonald of the Commission, Aztech Communication LLC (hereafter referred to "Aztech Communications") respectfully requests that the original Section 63.71 application that Aztech Communications submitted to the Commission on January 19, 2011 to Discontinue Local and Long Distance Services, be amended to include the following attached consumer notice.

The attached is a revision of the consumer notice that was originally included in the application, which was filed with the Commission in January. The consumer notice has now been revised so as to bring it into greater compliance with 47 C.F.R. 63.71. It will be mailed out to consumers on February 11, 2011.

Specifically, the consumer notice has been revised to comply with 47 C.F.R. 63.71, which requires language stating that consumers who wish to object have no later than 15 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance to file comments with the Commission. The original consumer notice sent by Aztech Communications had stated that consumers who wish to object had 15 days after receiving the consumer notice in order to file their comments with the Commission.

In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Federal Communications Commission rules, Aztech Communications, LLC has mailed a copy of this amendment to the Governor of the affected state (the State of Arizona), to the affected State public utility commission (the Arizona Corporations Commission) and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense.

Urgent & Important Notice Regarding the Termination of Your Local and Long Distance Services

Dear Customer:

Please be advised that Aztech Communications, LLC DBA EXPAND located at 1510 Boundary Cone Road, Mohave Valley, Arizona 86440, is terminating its Local and Long Distance Services and Internet. Therefore, it will no longer provide Local and Long Distance Services or Internet to you effective February 20, 2011. This letter serves as your 30-day notice of the discontinuation of Local and Long Distance Services from Aztech Communications.

You will receive your last bill from Aztech Communications before or shortly after the end of February 2011, for the balance of the services used during the months of January and/or February. Please note that there are other service providers that provide service in Mohave County that you can contact regarding service, such as Frontier Citizens Utilities Rural Telephone Company.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. Please call Aztech Communications at 1-928-577-0100 if you have questions regarding your current long distance bill or your final bill.

The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service (or reduction or impairment) unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. Address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, Washington, DC 20554 and include in your comments a reference to the § 63.71 Application of Aztech Communications, LLC. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance (or reduction or impairment) upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.
