Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 23, 2011, Robin Horwitz, CEO, Ed Bosson, VP, Regulatory Affairs, and David Bahar, Director of Government and Regulatory Affairs, all of Convo Communications, LLC (“Convo”), met with Paul de Sa, Chief, Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis.

During the meeting, Convo shared with Mr. de Sa several proposals pertinent to Video Relay Service (“VRS”) reform, including (1) suggestions on how to reach underserved VRS users; (2) suggestions on how to implement a centralized VRS authentication system, and (3) suggestions regarding the institution of an “access fee” to facilitate videophone portability.

This letter, as well as the written proposals and white paper on VRS technology that were shared with Mr. de Sa during the meeting, are being filed for inclusion in the public record of the Commission’s docket CG 10-51.

Further, Convo shared with Mr. de Sa a report containing independent research Convo has completed on the VRS industry. Although Convo believes it to be accurate in all material respects, it is not possible to guarantee its accuracy due to the nature of certain sources from which it was collected.
