Dear Mr. Davis:

This letter responds to your February 23, 2011 request that MegaPath, Inc. and Covad Communications Company (“Covad”) provide Sprint Nextel with access to all confidential and highly confidential documents that have been filed in the above referenced proceedings, including information filed in response to the Commission’s Public Notice released on October 28, 2010 (“Public Notice”).<sup>1</sup>

In accordance with the Commission’s October 28, 2010 notice, “[t]he data collected under this public notice will not be made immediately available to the public to allow staff time to perform an initial review for completeness and responsiveness.”<sup>2</sup> Therefore, Covad will not presently disclose its highly confidential responses to the Public Notice. To the extent required under the Protective Orders,<sup>3</sup> this letter serves as an objection to your February 23, 2011 request for production of Covad’s confidential and highly confidential responses.
