ORDER ON RULE COMPLIANCE

Applicable Rules on Licensee's Mailings/Filings

On January 24, 2011 the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) sent to you an official copy of *Order (FCC 11M-01)*, released January 18, 2011. It was mailed postage pre-paid to your designated (by you) address of record:

This Order was returned to the FCC on February 7, 2011 with advice: **Return to Sender Not Deliverable as Addressed Unable to Forward.**

Under FCC Rules: *all licensees are required to keep their license information (including their address) current. See sections of the Rules regarding responsibility of licensee/grantee to keep the FCC informed of his/her current address.*¹ In this regard, Section 97.23 (Mailing Address) provides:

Revocation of the station license or suspension of the operator license may result when correspondence from the FCC is returned as undeliverable because the grantee failed to provide the correct mailing address.

The Commission takes serious the current location of licensees, and is prepared to revoke licensee truants. Therefore, you are directed to file and serve a notification of change of address to the FCC by **February 22, 2011**. **FCC Form 605** should be utilized for this purpose.

HDO Discrepancies

On January 12, 2011 the FCC adopted Hearing Designation Order (DA 11-58) [HDO], WT Docket No. 11-7, designating Glenn A. Baxter's Application to Renew License for Amateur Radio Service Station K1MAN for hearing. As stated in *Order* (FCC 11M-01), released January 18, 2011, this hearing case has been assigned to Chief Administrative Law Judge, Richard L. Sippel, and a prehearing conference has been set for **March 3, 2011** in Washington, D.C.

Chief Judge Sippel has reviewed the HDO. Clarification of some information is needed. Please review the following questions and provide your responses to the Chief Judge.

1. Did you receive the officially mailed copy of the HDO and when did you receive it?
2. What is your current mailing address? What is your current home/street address? What is your home telephone number? What is your official e-mail address?
3. Is the address on your renewal application current and correct?


