In the process of our parting of the ways Reese Butler erased a lot of my personal stuff on my e-mail address including a picture of my niece, and then asked for his phone to be returned. I asked him if I could hold onto the phone until I could get another so I could call 911 in the event of an emergency being that I am on a horse and out in the middle of nowhere and his reply was that someone would pull over and to send his phone back. I would strongly suggest that 1-800-Suicide stay in the hands of SAMHSA/NSPL so that people in need get the help they need from people who are truly compassionate and wanting to help these people and not use this as a means to generate money which is what the KBHC and Reese Butler seem to put as their first priority as a matter of fact it seems to be their only priority.
