Dear Sirs:

The Plainfield Community Consolidated School District #202 ("District 202") would like to respectfully submit a Request for Waiver of the Rules of the Universal Service Program for Schools and Libraries ("E-rate Program"), to re-open these Funding Requests and allow District 202 to file for BEAR reimbursement for eligible services delivered and paid for during Funding Year 2009.

District 202 asks the FCC to grant a Waiver of the Rules to allowing us the opportunity to submit reimbursement the USAC-SLD on these funding requests. Due to a series of reasons, primary of which includes the need for clarification of the accuracy of our bills with our service providers, District 202 could not appropriately file the needed evidence to support the invoicing and reimbursement of these services, in accordance with E-rate rules and regulations. The services seeking support here were eligible voice, cellular, data and internet access services from providers Illinois Bell, Nextel and AT&T Mobility.

In addition, the Technology Dept went through a major overall and was combined with another department that was reduced in staff and included major issues with a large project in progress.

We note here that the Waiver of the Rules would serve the public interest by allowing the District to offset payments on its eligible telecommunications services, and would not adversely affect current or future E-rate applicants.

District 202 serves 28,942 students from a wide range of socio-economic groups. As with many schools across the nation, our District has tackled budget and service cuts and teacher and staff reductions in the face of declining education dollars. E-rate support is critical to our ability to serve our students and staff.
