This letter concerns the Domestic Section 214 Application filed jointly by Blue Casa Communications, Inc. (Blue Casa) and Blue Casa Telephone, LLC, (BCT) on February 7, 2011 (Application) for the Acquisition of Blue Casa's Assets by BCT.

On February 28, 2011, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) filed Comments on the Application expressing our concerns to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that Blue Casa owed monies to California and to its customers related to our state Lifeline program and the CPUC's user fees. Since the filing of our comments, the CPUC and the applicants have successfully resolved all of the issues identified in our comments. The applicants have provided additional information to the CPUC regarding the proposed transaction which shows how they plan to repay their debts to California and their customers. For these reasons, the CPUC now hereby requests that its previously-filed comments be withdrawn.
