Dear Ms. Dortch:

With reference to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended, 47 USC §214(a), Vivaro Corporation ("Transferee") hereby requests a 60-day extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") that is due to expire March 29, 2011 to allow STi Prepaid, LLC ("STi" or the "Company") to continue to provide interstate telecommunications services pending action on an application for permanent Section 214 authority for the transfer of control of STi to Transferee. The application is under consideration in WC Docket No. 10-205.

On January 28, 2011, the Wireline Competition Bureau granted STA in this matter for a 60-day period that expires March 29, 2011. The International Bureau on January 31, 2011 also granted STA for a 60-day period that expires April 1, 2011. An extension of STA is needed to allow additional time for "Team Telecom" to complete its review of the transaction and provide input to the Commission concerning the subject application. Joanne P. Ongman, Attorney, Foreign Investment Review Staff, National Security Division, U.S. Department of Justice, has authorized the undersigned to state that Team Telecom has no objection to extension of STA for a 60-day period.

Extension of STA will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity because it will permit the continued provision of service by STi without interruption to customers while the Commission considers the application for approval of the transfer of control.

Transferee acknowledges that extension of STA will not prejudice any action the Commission may take on the underlying application for Commission consent to the transfer of control of STi. Transferee further acknowledges that STA may be revoked by the Commission upon its own motion without a hearing.
