Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.1200, *et seq.*, Harris Corporation (“Harris”) hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) of the following ex parte communication in the above-referenced proceeding. On March 17, 2011, on behalf of Harris, Dr. Gregory Henderson and Reid Johnson met with: Jennifer Manner, Behzad Ghaffari, Pat Amodio, Brian Hurley, Jason Kim, Yoon Chang, Kurian Jacob, Erika Olsen and Henning Schulzrinne of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau; Ziad Sleem of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and Michael Ha of the Office of Engineering and Technology.

In the meeting, representatives from seven equipment manufacturers (Harris, Alcatel-Lucent, Motorola, IP Wireless, LGE, Nokia Siemens, and Ericsson) presented information on public safety network interoperability requirements that would allow for build-out of the 700 MHz Long Term Evolution wireless broadband network. Following the presentation the group engaged in a question and answer session led by Commission staff.
