Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 28, 2011, Chris Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, and Brian Josef, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA - The Wireless Association®, along with Jeanine Poltronieri of AT&T, Ray Rothermel of Sprint Nextel and Tamara Preiss of Verizon, met with Charles Mathias, Senior Legal Advisor, and Rafi Martina, Fellow, in the Office of Commissioner Meredith Attwell Baker. During the meeting, the parties discussed the ongoing proceeding regarding the use of signal boosters and other signal amplification techniques for wireless services.

CTIA and carriers expressed their support for an FCC Declaratory Ruling affirming and enforcing the requirement in its rules that a FCC license, or express licensee consent, is necessary to operate a signal booster. The parties also noted support for a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to inform the evaluation and development of technical and operational features for signal boosters to address interference. Finally, the parties voiced concern regarding the potential adoption of interim rules without notice and comment.
