This letter is to inform you that on March 30, 2011, Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint”), through its representatives Charles W. McKee and Maria L. Cattafesta, met with Louis Peraertz (Legal Advisor, Wireless, International, and Public Safety for Commissioner Clyburn) regarding the above-referenced proceeding. In that meeting, Sprint expressed its support for Chairman Genachowski’s decision to include a data roaming item on the Commission’s April 7 meeting agenda and emphasized the importance of a meaningful data roaming obligation to promote competition consistent with its prior filings in this docket. In particular, Sprint underscored the need for an effective FCC enforcement mechanism to serve as a backstop for reasonable data roaming arrangements in light of significant changes in the dynamics of the roaming market.
