This is to inform you that on Wednesday, March 30, 2011, Russell Merbeth, Vice President of Government Affairs for Leap Wireless International, Inc. and Cricket Communications, Inc. (together, "Leap") and the undersigned (the "Leap Representatives") met with Louis Peraertz, wireless legal advisor to Commissioner Clyburn. On Thursday, March 31, 2011, the Leap Representatives met with Margaret McCarthy, Policy Advisor to Commissioner Copps.

In these meetings, the Leap Representatives reiterated Leap's support for the imposition of a data roaming obligation, as set forth in Leap's filings in the above-referenced proceeding. In particular, the Leap Representatives urged the Commission to ensure that any data roaming rule that is adopted contain a meaningful and enforceable legal standard, and a robust enforcement framework. They also asked that any caveats to the legal standard that may be imposed to address the technical or generational incompatibility of wireless networks not permit a carrier to cite minor differences in LTE technology as a basis for a refusal to provide data roaming.
