**RE: Notice - Operations Support Systems Integration Report**

***Applications Filed by Frontier Communications Corporation and Verizon Communications Inc. for Assignment or Transfer of Control; WC Docket 09-95***

Dear Ms. Dortch:

In compliance with its commitments under the Commission's May 21 Order,<sup>1</sup> Frontier Communications Corporation ("Frontier") is submitting this Operations Support Systems Integration Report ("Integration Report") on behalf of its operating subsidiaries in North Carolina, South Carolina, Michigan and Indiana which were acquired from Verizon Communications Inc. on July 1, 2010. Specifically, Condition # 8 in Appendix C of the Commission's Order provides:

*If, within three years after the Transaction Closing Date, Frontier plans to transition from any of the support systems transferred from Verizon to Frontier's legacy systems, or to any new systems, subject to appropriate confidentiality protections, Frontier will prepare and submit a detailed operations support system ("OSS") integration plan to the Wireline Competition Bureau, and the state commission of any affected state. . . . Frontier also will commit to provide this OSS integration plan to the Wireline Competition Bureau and commission of any affected state no less than 180 days prior to implementing the system transition, subject to appropriate confidentiality protections.*

Frontier has prepared the attached Integration Report to fulfill this condition and in anticipation of the systems conversion in which Frontier will migrate customers located in North Carolina, South Carolina, Michigan and Indiana from the Verizon-replicated OSS to the Frontier legacy OSS. The planned conversion is scheduled to occur on or after October 1, 2011.

Also, in accordance with Condition # 9 in the Commission's Order,<sup>2</sup> Frontier is making this Integration Plan available to competitive local exchange carriers in its service territory to provide these carriers with an opportunity to review and provide input to Frontier regarding the Integration Plan.
