This letter is submitted pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206.

On March 31, 2011, Dr. Brendan Traw, Chief Technology Officer, Digital Home Group, and Jeffrey Lawrence, Director Global Content Policy, both of Intel Corporation, and the undersigned met with the following persons:

- Douglas Sicker, Chief Technologist
- Mary Beth Murphy, Chief of the Policy Division, Alison Neplokh, Chief Engineer of Office of the Bureau Chief, and Brendan Murray, Media Bureau.

At the meeting, Dr. Traw and Mr. Lawrence discussed industry progress on home networking technologies such as DLNA CVP-1 and DTCP-IP. They reiterated Intel's support for open industry standards and discussed the innovation opportunities created by standard interfaces. Intel is a strong proponent of open ecosystems enabled by industry-agreed standards, which Intel prefers over regulatory mandates. Dr. Traw answered questions regarding the maturity of these various technologies and the roles of the standards bodies that advance them, and regarding the different approaches that the Media Bureau is considering. Although Intel had attended a CEA meeting at the Commission, CEA does not speak for Intel. Intel desires to work with all parties toward an industry-agreed standard IP interface.
