Montana State University ("MSU"), by its counsel, hereby submits the following reply comments with regard to the Commission's Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("NPRM") in the above-captioned proceeding to transfer channel *46, Kalispell, Montana to the Post-Transition Table of DTV Allotments (the "Post-Transition Table"). MSU initiated this proceeding to transfer the existing Kalispell channel *46 allotment from the Pre-Transition Table of DTV Allotments to the Post-Transition Table. MSU filed comments in support of the NPRM on March 25, 2011, and Flathead Adventist Radio, Inc. also filed comments in support of the NPRM on March 24, 2011.
