Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter serves to correct an error within the comments filed by CenturyLink on April 1, 2011 in these dockets. The comments on page 8 should be corrected to read:

Yet based on current census data, fully 89% of CenturyLink's service territory has fewer than 50 people per square mile. 84% has fewer than 30 per square mile. 79% has fewer than 20. Only 6% of the company's footprint has a population of 100 or more people per square mile.

The filing inadvertently understated the first three percentages as 78%, 74%, and 70%, respectively.

Likewise, on page 2 the statement should read: "84% of CenturyLink's service territory is in low-density high-cost environments with fewer than 30 people per square mile."
