REPLY COMMENTS OF ONELINK WIRELESS, INC.

OneLink Wireless, Inc. (“OneLink”), by undersigned counsel, hereby responds to the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission”) Public Notice released March 8, 2011 seeking comment on OneLink’s petition for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) in the states of Alabama, New York, North Carolina, and Virginia.¹

No comments were filed in response to the Commission’s Public Notice. Therefore, the Commission should act quickly to designate OneLink as an ETC. As detailed in its Petition, OneLink satisfies all of the necessary requirements to be designated as an ETC for the limited purposes of offering services supported by the Lifeline and Link Up programs, as required by section 214(e)(6) of the Communications Act and Sections 54.210-54.209 of the Commission’s rules.² Designating OneLink as an ETC would also promote the public interest because it would provide qualifying low-income customers with lower priced, high-quality wireless services, and access to a host of add-on service features. For these reasons, OneLink urges the Commission to act quickly and grant its Petition for designation as an ETC at the earliest date possible.
