
Re: Notification of *Ex Parte* Communication

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise you, in accordance with Section 1.1206 of the FCC's rules, that yesterday, April 21, 2011, George L. Mahoney, Vice President, Secretary, and General Counsel of Media General, Inc. ("Media General"), and I met with Amy Levine, Special Counsel to Chairman Julius Genachowski. In the meeting, Mr. Mahoney discussed the issues Media General addressed, and the positions that it advocated, in its comments filed March 18, 2011, in the above-captioned docket. Mr. Mahoney emphasized that changes effectuated through market mechanisms are highly preferable to government-based solutions because they more accurately value properties and result in more innovation and public interest benefits. Any change in broadcasters' status as users of the television bands from primary to co-primary should be preceded by thorough consideration of the interference problems that may result, he said.
