On May 9, 2011, the undersigned, along with Mary McManus of Comcast and Terri Natoli of Time Warner Cable, met with Angela Kronenberg, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Clyburn, to discuss the broadband performance testing process being conducted by the Commission's contractor, SamKnows. We updated Ms. Kronenberg on the status of the testing process and expressed support for the manner in which SamKnows and the Commission staff have collaborated with participating Internet Service Providers and other interested parties. As the Commission prepares to release the results of the initial phase of testing, we explained the importance of presenting the data in a manner that accurately reflects the typical experience of test panelists, including the additional speed delivered by the PowerBoost technology used by many cable operators.
