Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 10, 2011, Ron Wheeler, Senior Vice President, Content Protection, Fox Group, spoke by telephone with Edward Lazarus of the Commission to discuss matters related to the above-referenced proceedings.

During the call, Mr. Wheeler reiterated that there was increasing evidence that marketplace developments are superseding the need for government action when it comes to the retail availability of devices consumers use to access video content in the home. Specifically, Mr. Wheeler explained that, in the course of renegotiating a contract with one of Fox's multichannel video programming distribution ("MVPD") partners, the MVPD has told Fox that it intends in the near future to make its subscription and on-demand video services available directly to widely-marketed consumer electronics devices, such as game consoles. As a result, Fox has been specifically asked that the new agreement include permission to deliver Fox content to such devices.
