

MHMRA of Harris County is accredited by the American Association of Suicidology and is a member of the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. We have no affiliation with KBHC, however, in September 2010 a colleague informed me that my agency's name was listed on the KBHC website in a way that looked like we were affiliated with services that they provide. I went to their website and did see my agency listed there despite the fact that we have no written MOU or contract with this entity. I called all the numbers listed on their website since it was written in a way that made it appear my agency was responding to these calls, to determine if these calls were being sent to our phones without our knowledge. I was able to get ahold of someone through the PDDMOMS number and the VET number. The youth number sent me to a phone tree where I held for 10 minutes before I disconnected. I did this twice to confirm I had not misdialed. The spanish line 1-800-SUICIDA was answered by an auto supply company. We called this number twice as well to ensure we had not misdialed. These calls were all made on September 10, 2010.
