I hereby request your assistance, advice and opinion on several matters of interest. Please forward me your opinion and comments related, but not limited, to the following subjects: the legal aspects of the merger; if the proposed merger complies with all the applicable laws dealing with monopolistic issues or controversies; which agency or department will have jurisdiction over the merger and over the resulting entity (which I understand will be AT&T); which agency or department will have jurisdiction over the rates, tariffs and other charges to be applied to the consumers; which agency or department will have jurisdiction over the complaints, if any, to be filed by the consumers; if pre-emption exists as to federal laws over the laws of Puerto Rico, which


