On May 12, 2011, Grant Beckmann, Scot Brooksby and Jamie Locke of Sorenson Communications, Inc. ("Sorenson") met with Richard Hovey of the FCC's Wireline Competition Bureau and Henning Schulzrinne of the FCC's Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau. At that meeting the parties discussed the technologies and processes required to transition from H.323 to SIP, and the various technological capabilities that could be enabled with a SIP standard. The parties also discussed the stakeholder collaboration that will be required to do so. The parties also discussed the importance of not mandating a standard in an FCC rule, but, rather, allowing for future flexibility and innovation.
