Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.1200, *et seq.*, Harris Corporation (“Harris”) hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) of the following ex parte communication in the above-referenced proceeding. On May 12, 2011, on behalf of Harris, Mr. Patrick Sullivan met with: Jennifer Manner, Gene Fullano, Behzad Ghaffari, Pat Amodio, Brian Hurley, of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau; Ziad Sleem of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and Michael Ha of the Office of Engineering and Technology.
