On May 5, 2011, Melanie Bostwick and I had a telephone conference with Ann Stevens and Jodie May of the Commission. The purpose of the meeting was to follow up on our previous discussion on April 5, 2011, concerning a proposed procedural mechanism for the transfer of responsibility for the SMS/800 Functions Tariff from the BOCs to SMS/800, Inc.

The discussions addressed the potential impact of previous Commission rulemakings on the proposed transfer of tariff responsibility. In addition, the participants discussed whether the fact that SMS/800 services are provided to non-U.S. customers would implicate any particular procedures. The Commission also asked about the status of the BOCs' discussions with the industry regarding the proposed transfer.
