On May 18, 2011, Rick Chessen and Steve Morris of the National Cable & Telecommunications Association (NCTA), met with Zac Katz (Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski), Jordan Usdan (OSPPA), Henning Schulzrinne (PSHSB), Lynne Ratnavale (CGB- by phone), and Walter Johnston and James Miller (Office of Engineering and Technology) to discuss the disclosure requirements adopted by the Commission in the above-referenced proceeding. Matt Polka (by phone), Ross Lieberman, Barbara Esbin, and Alexandra Liopiros also participated in the meeting, and filed a separate ex parte letter, on behalf of the American Cable Association.

During the meeting, NCTA discussed concerns that were raised in its April 11, 2011 comments regarding the compliance burdens attributable to the disclosure rules. We also discussed the proposals for clarifying those rules that were included in NCTA's comments. In particular, we discussed the potential costs and benefits of clarifying the Commission's expectations with regard to disclosure of "actual" performance of the services provided by ISPs.
