Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.1200, *et seq.*, Harris Corporation (“Harris”) hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) of the following ex parte communication in the above-referenced proceeding. On May 20, 2011, on behalf of Harris, Mary Doherty, Kyle Connor, and Vineet Jolly, and on behalf of Nokia Siemens Network (“NSN”), Mark Combs, Robert Fennelly, Brian Kassa, and Christopher Stark met with Jennifer Manner of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau at the NSN facility in Irving, TX.

During this meeting, Harris provided an overview, as reflected in the attached presentation, of the regional VIDA Integrated Network. Harris and NSN discussed with Ms. Manner the opinion that comments received in the above-referenced proceeding lacked the level of detail and specificity needed to define interoperability requirements, and how those inputs could be provided to the FCC.
