On May 24, 2011, William Cobb, Lydia Runnels and the undersigned of CSDVRS, LLC (“CSDVRS”) met with William Dever, Richard Hovey and Heather Hendrickson of the Wireline Competition Bureau. CSDVRS discussed several topics related to the Commission’s 2010 Notice of Proposed Rulemaking regarding toll free iTRS numbers. CSDVRS’ comments were consistent with the key points made in its responsive comments to the NPRM filed in the CG 10-51 Docket (<http://fjallfoss.fcc.gov/ecfs/document/view?id=7020921998>). CSDVRS discussed toll free number costs, the use of toll free numbers by the deaf community, and the requirement to have all toll free numbers in the iTRS database. CSDVRS explained that a limited number of toll free numbers have been provided to certain eligible relay users who are unable to receive geographically appropriate telephone numbers to prevent inequity in their telecommunications access if they were required to use numbers which impose long distance costs. CSDVRS stressed the need to ensure that any toll free number assigned to a video phone must be immediately registered in the iTRS database and promptly available to all other providers for signaling, routing of either VRS or point-to-point calls, and porting.
