Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 25, 2011, Dale Schmick, Chief Strategy Officer of YourTel, Inc. and Chairman of COMPTEL, and the undersigned met with Kimberly Scardino, Jamie Susskind, Cindy Spiers and Graham Dufault of the Wireline Competition Bureau regarding Lifeline Link Up reform and modernization. Consistent with the comments and reply comments COMPTEL filed in the above-captioned proceedings, we voiced support for the Commission's proposal to develop and implement a national database that could be used to verify consumer eligibility for Lifeline service and check for duplicate claims. We reiterated the value of toll limitation service as a mechanism for low income consumers to control their telephone expenditures and the need for continued universal service fund subsidization of the service. We also addressed issues related to Link Up support,¹ the Commission's one-per-residence proposed rule changes² and support amounts for voice services.³
