Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, the undersigned counsel hereby provides notice that on May 25, 2011, Kristin Brooks Hope Center's attorneys met with Zachary Katz, Legal Advisor, Office of Chairman Julius Genachowski; Julie Veach and Diane Griffin Holland, Office of the General Counsel; Lisa Gelb, Jennifer Prime, Ann Stevens, and Michelle Sclater of the Wireline Competition Bureau, in the proceeding identified above. In attendance on behalf of the Kristin Brooks Hope Center were Steven A. Augustino, Kelley Drye & Warren LLP and H. Reese Butler, Founder.

During the meeting, KBHC argued that the Commission must end the temporary reassignment and return the toll free numbers to KBHC. The Commission does not have either a factual or legal basis here to depart from its first-come, first-served policy for the assignment of toll free numbers. In particular, KBHC noted that there is no imminent public safety emergency and no risk of disconnection of the numbers if they were returned to KBHC. SAMHSA's position asks the Commission to judge whether an entity is capable of operating a mental health hotline, which is an inquiry that is beyond the Commission's expertise and is contrary to Commission precedent. KBHC further noted that it had demonstrated that its finances are stable

and made several commitments in the record that provide additional assurances that no harm would arise from the return of the three toll free numbers to KBHC. The positions presented were consistent with those Kristin Brooks Hope Center presented on the record.
