The above-captioned joint domestic and international Section 214 application was filed on May 19, 2011. Pursuant to an informal request from the Wireline Competition Bureau staff, the Applicants hereby supplement the application with additional information concerning Mimi Acquisition Company. Specifically, the Applicants confirm that Mimi Acquisition Company (“MergerSub”) is a Delaware corporation formed for the purpose of effectuating the proposed transaction. As set forth in the application, MergerSub is a direct, wholly-owned subsidiary of CenturyLink, Inc. MergerSub will be merged with and into SAVVIS, Inc. on the closing date, with SAVVIS, Inc. surviving as a wholly-owned subsidiary of CenturyLink, Inc., and MergerSub ceasing to exist.
