This is to inform you that on June 2, 2011, representatives from AT&T (Hank Hultquist), Verizon (Donna Epps, David Young and Mark Montano), Windstream (Jennie Chandra), CenturyLink (Jeb Benedict), Frontier (Mike Saperstein), and USTelecom (Kevin Rupy and Glenn Reynolds) met with the following Commission staff in connection with the docket identified above to discuss the broadband performance testing process being conducted by the Commission and its contractor, SamKnows: Zac Katz, Henning Schulzrinne, Jordan Usdan, Deborah Bonderson, Walter Johnston, James Miller, Lynn Ratnavale, Douglas Sicker, and Jonathan Zittrain.

During this meeting, we discussed how the public interest would be best served by ensuring that the Commission's report on the results of the SamKnows testing focus on providing consumers with an objective analysis of the test data and include the release of all such data. In particular, industry participants urged the staff to acknowledge in the report the importance of sustained broadband speeds to consumers. We also urged the Commission to move as expeditiously as possible to releasing the report to the public.
