NOTICE OF EX PARTE PRESENTATION

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 14, 2011, on behalf of my client, TracFone Wireless, Inc., I met with Kimberly Scardino of the Wireline Competition Bureau Telecommunications Access Policy Division. We discussed differences between Eligible Telecommunications Carriers which provide Universal Service Fund-supported services in whole or in part using their own facilities and those Eligible Telecommunications Carriers who provide Universal Service Fund-supported services solely by reselling facilities and services of other providers. We also discussed whether there should be differences in the requirements and conditions applicable to Eligible Telecommunications Carriers, particularly with respect to Lifeline services, depending on whether such carriers are deemed to be “facilities-based” or resale providers. The positions expressed by undersigned counsel during that meeting were consistent with TracFone’s prior written submissions in the above-captioned docketed proceedings.
