On June 13 and 14, 2011, I participated on behalf of the National Association of State Utility Consumer Advocates (NASUCA) in the Federal Communications Commission's 2 day Workshop on Low Income Database Issues. The Workshop focused on issues concerning the construction and operation a database for Lifeline and Link-Up programs, including both technical, policy and consumer protections concerns. The Workshop was led by Kimberly Scardino, Cindy Spiers, and Jonathan Lechter of the Commission's Wireline Competition Bureau staff.
