**Re: Notice of Ex Parte Presentation
Tribune Company, Debtor-in-Possession
MB Docket No. 10-104**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is submitted in connection with the above-captioned pending applications of Tribune Company, Debtor-in-Possession (“Tribune”) to apprise the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) of the filing of applications with the Commission for the transfer of control of affiliates of Millennium Radio Group, LLC (“Millennium”), as listed on Attachment A hereto. If the Millennium transfer applications are granted and the transaction is consummated, Oaktree Capital Group Holdings, L.P. (“Oaktree”), an affiliate of Tribune’s proposed attributable stockholder, Oaktree Tribune, L.P., then would be deemed to hold, in compliance with the Commission’s rules, certain attributable radio broadcast interests within the Tribune television markets of New York (WPIX(TV)) and Philadelphia (WPHL-TV). See FCC Public Notice Rept. No. 27487 (released May 16, 2011).

The multiple ownership exhibit in the Millennium transfer applications includes a demonstration that the Commission’s rules permit Oaktree to hold both its proposed attributable interest in Tribune and those additional attributable radio broadcast interests in the New York and Philadelphia television markets that it would acquire upon consummation of the Millennium transfer. In addition, because the relevant contours of Millennium’s radio stations do not encompass the community of publication of Tribune’s daily newspaper, The Morning Call, in Allentown, Pennsylvania or the daily newspaper in which Tribune continues to hold a minority interest, Newsday, in Melville, New York, Oaktree’s proposed attributable interest in Millennium complies with the FCC’s newspaper broadcast cross-ownership rule.

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Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b)(2), a copy of this notice is being filed electronically.
