On behalf of CommScope, Inc. (“CommScope”) and pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter provides notice of an *ex parte* meeting held by telephone on June 17, 2011 in connection with PS Docket No. 07-114 and WC Docket No. 05-196. The meeting was attended by Mr. James Winterbottom, Global Product Manager-IP Location Systems of CommScope and George Marble, Director-Business Development (the “CommScope Representatives”) as well as David Furth, Deputy Chief; Tom Beers, Division Chief; Patrick Donovan; David Siehl; Stanley Scheiner; Jerry Stanshine; Henning Schulzrinne; and Rizwan Chowdhry with the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (the “FCC Representatives”).

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss emergency caller location technology for multiple access service types, including DSL, cable, femtocell, and WiFi, and CommScope’s experiences with emergency caller location regulations. During the discussion, the CommScope Representatives advised the FCC Representatives about its recently announced wireless indoor location solution and its development of an IP-based location architecture component, Location Information Server (LIS).
