Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 13, 2011, AT&T Inc. ("AT&T") filed a hard drive containing documents from the files of designated custodians that are responsive to the Commission's Information and Discovery Request dated May 27, 2011 in the AT&T/T-Mobile proceeding referenced above ("AT&T/T-Mobile Request"). It has come to AT&T's attention that, among the over 180,000 documents and almost 1.4 million pages on this hard drive, certain Highly Confidential documents were inadvertently produced that were non-responsive to a Request or were documents that Commission Staff had agreed should not be produced in response to the AT&T/T-Mobile Request. These documents contain Highly Confidential information belonging to various third parties as well as AT&T. AT&T is withdrawing these documents from its production. Accordingly, AT&T is submitting a revised hard drive that excludes the inadvertently produced Highly Confidential documents, and respectfully requests that the Commission withdraw as responsive to the AT&T/T-Mobile Request the hard drive submitted on June 13, 2011 that contained this Highly Confidential information.

The revised hard drive also contains updated Confidential indices for the production volumes that reflect the corrections to the custodian information. Two redacted copies of these indices are also provided with this letter.
