On June 28, 2011, Laurence S. Zimmerman, Sam Wauchope, Leonard Z. Sotomayor, and Aandrea Carter of Landover Wireless, LLC (“Landover”), together with John Janka and the undersigned of Latham & Watkins LLP, met with the following Commission personnel to discuss Landover’s interest in promoting opportunities for entrepreneurs to deploy wireless broadband services using broadcast television spectrum: William Lake, Barbara Kreisman, Hossein Hashemzadeh, and Dorann Bunkin of the Media Bureau; Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning & Policy Analysis; and Amy Levine, Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski. Landover proposed that the Commission should allow entrepreneurs to build out two-way mobile broadband networks on an accelerated time frame, subject to conditions that would result in the return of licenses if such deployment did not occur. All such constructed networks should be taken into account and protected in any repack initiative. We also discussed the many benefits that would result from such an approach, including the speedy deployment of affordable wireless service, including in unserved areas.
