On June 30, 2011, Corie Wright of Free Press spoke via telephone with Joshua Cinelli, Media Advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps. During the call, Ms. Wright expressed support for the recent FCC staff report recommendation that the Commission make disclosure a "pillar of FCC media policy."¹ In doing so she reiterated arguments that she and other public interest group representatives advanced in a meeting with FCC Media Bureau staff on June 29, 2011.
